Primary 4 Weighted Assessment (3) Schedule 2026

This letter provides details of the Term 3 Weighted Assessments (WA3). Please refer to Annex 1 for the schedule and scope of assessment.

Assessment Approach

Assessment is an integral part of our students' learning process and goes beyond tests and examinations. In everyday learning, the school uses a variety of teaching and assessment approaches, including in-class work, class discussions, homework and weighted assessments (WAs). We encourage students to set aside time daily to revise their lessons and complete their homework on time, so that teachers can provide timely feedback on their learning progress.

Assessment Weightings

The assessment weightings for Primary 4 are shown in the table below.

To support their learning, absentees will be allowed to attempt the pen-and-paper WA at home and submit the completed papers to their subject teachers for feedback.
