Student Agency and Independence

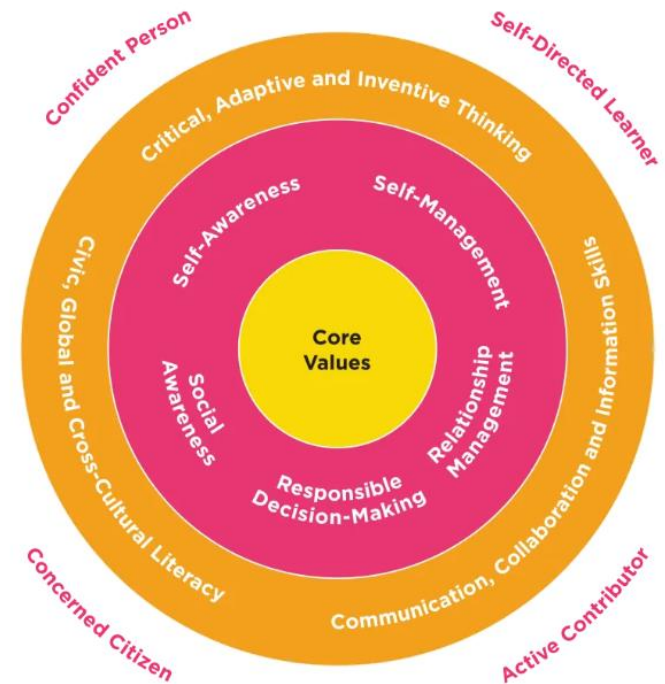
