### Reading and Viewing



#### **SHARED READING EXPERIENCES**



#### REINFORCEMENT OF LANGUAGE USE

#### **Listening Practices**

Listening exercises will be done in the classroom throughout the year

#### **Weekly Spelling**

Weekly Spelling and Dictation (every Tuesday) only starting from Term 2.

The list of words (linked to STELLAR) will be given to the students before the term begins

## Grammar & Vocabulary Practices

Reinforce what has been taught with additional practices

#### Penmanship

STELLAR Handwriting book to teach students to properly form letters of the alphabet (penmanship). Emphasis on proper grip and neat letter formation is reinterated in the classroom.
