Before the start of the session:

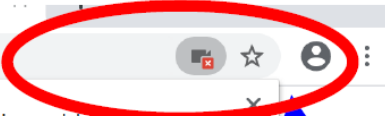
- Please ensure that you join at least 10-15 minutes before the start of the session
- Click on the link provided in SLS to access the Google Meet session

Camera and microphone are blocked

Meet requires access to your camera and microphone. Click the camera blocked icon  in your browser's address bar.

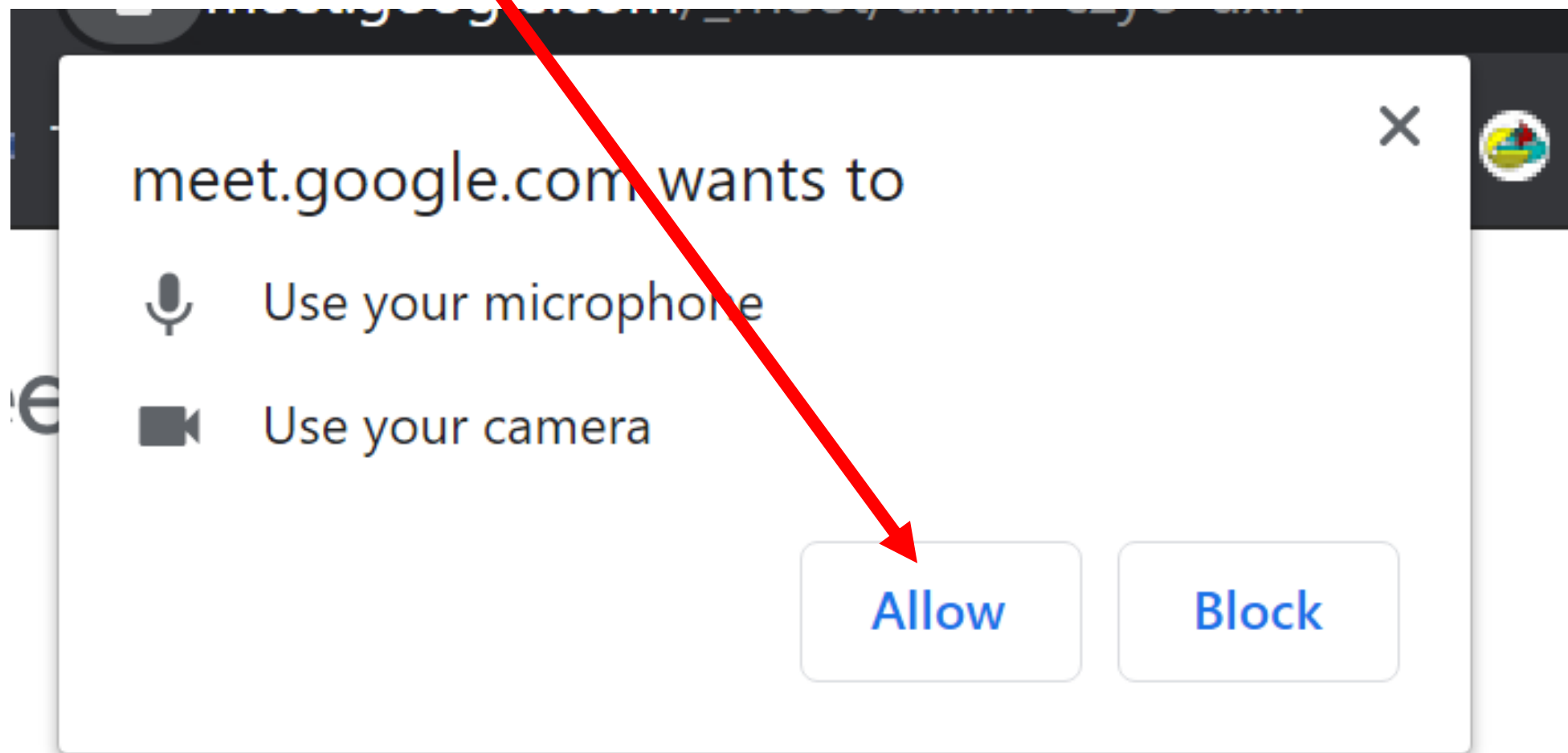

1. Click 'Allow'




2. Type in **your name** (`name_class`) and click 'Ask to join'

3. **Wait** for the teacher to grant your access

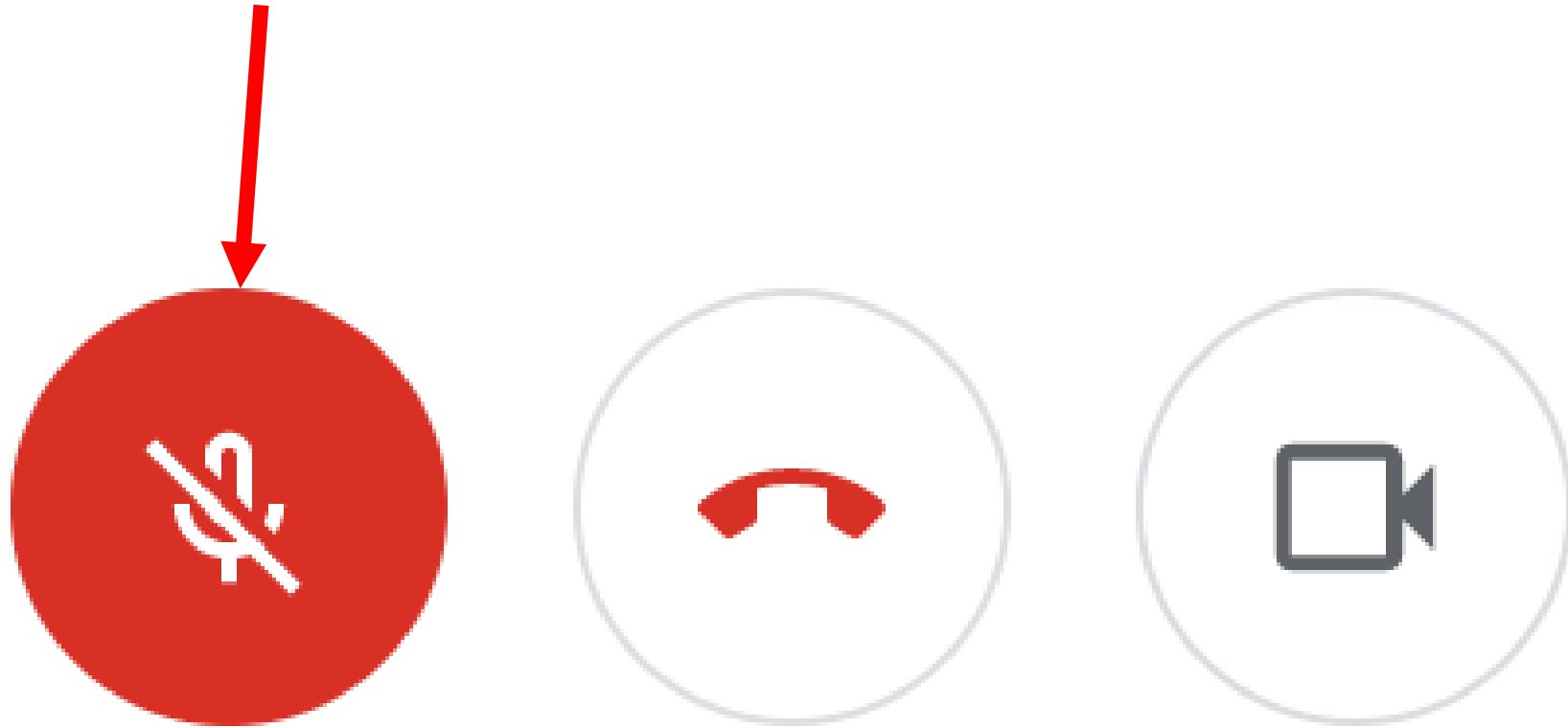
